



Criteria for Adventurer Club of the Year

This form outlines the criteria used to evaluate and select the Adventurer Club of the Year. Clubs are assessed based on administration, member engagement, program completion, participation, outreach, and creativity. Total: **100 Points**

1. Spiritual Growth and Mission – 15 pts

- Number of Adventurer Baptized (5pts)
- Club initiates or participates in at least one community service project (5 pts)
- Active support or partnership with local church ministry (5 pts)

2. Club Organization and Administration – 15 pts

- Club Registration submitted on time – (*September 1-30*) (5 pts)
- Club Monthly Reports submitted consistently (5 pts)
- Club Calendar aligned with Conference/District events (5 pts)

3. Participation and Engagement – 30 pts

- Active participation of Adventurers in at least 80% of meetings (10 pts)
- Regular parent/guardian involvement in club activities (5 pts)
- Participation in District/Conference events (*Family Fair, Adventurer Bible Game, Adventurer Family Fun Day, Leadership Convention, Outreach, Camporee*) (10 pts)
- Participation in special emphasis days (*Pray & Go, World Adventurer Day etc.*) (5 pts)

4. Curriculum Completion – 20 pts

- Completion of classwork and awards for each level (*Little Lamb to Helping Hand*) (15 pts)
- Participation in Investiture Service (5 pts)

5. Teamwork and Leadership Development – 15 pts

- Innovative programs, theme days, or unique club projects (5 pts)
- Club newsletter, social media updates, or visual displays (5 pts)
- Leaders attend required training sessions (5 pts)

6. Uniform and Standards – 5 pts

- Club maintains uniform standards (5 pts)

Note: To be eligible for Adventurer Club of the Year, the Club must have representation at Directors' meeting and Leadership Convention.
